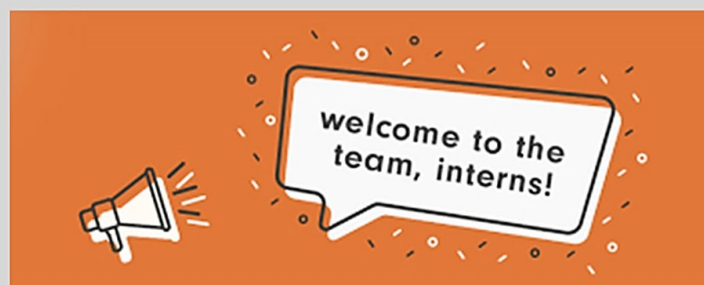

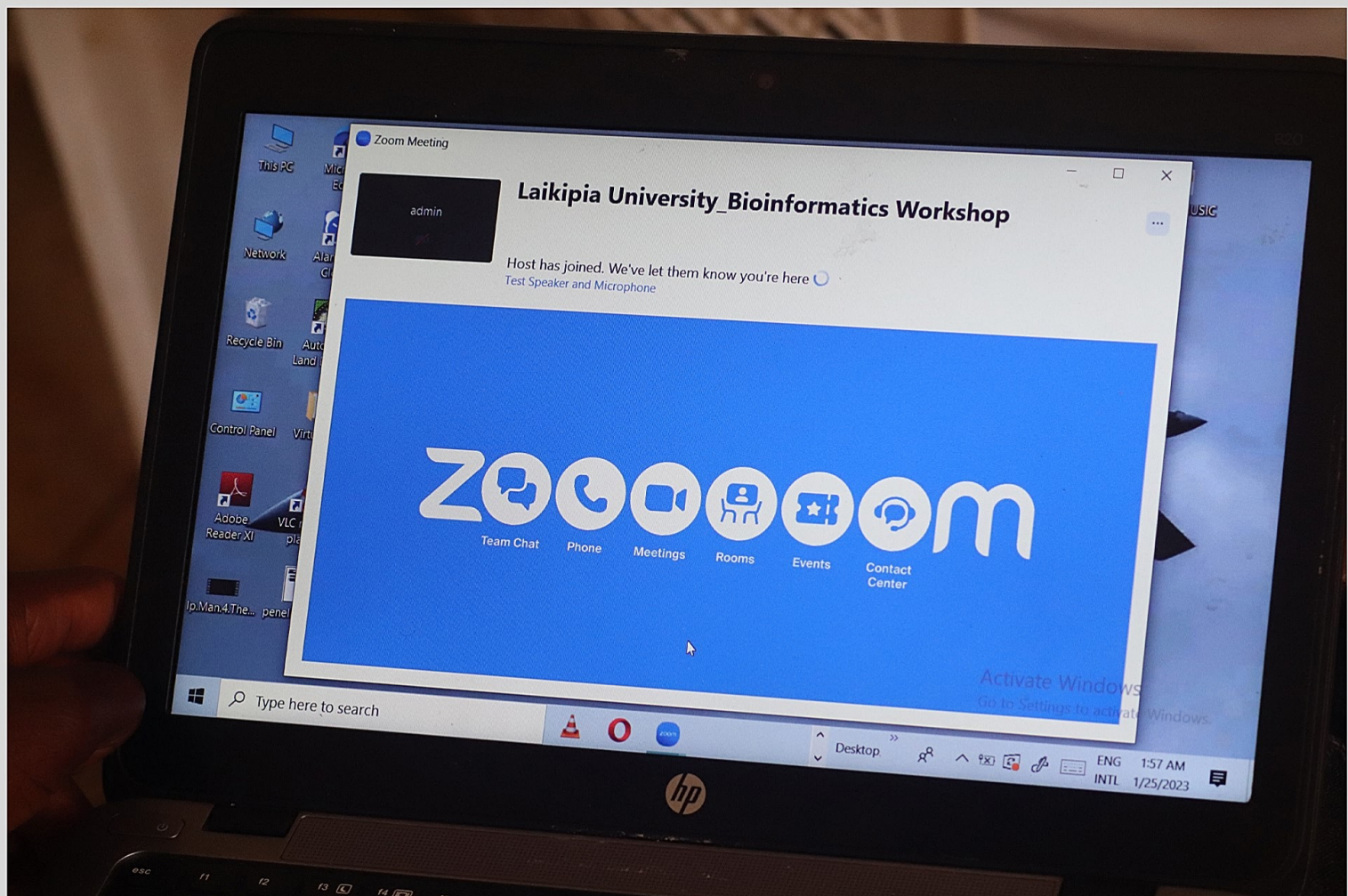

Tree Planting to Mark International Day of Forests

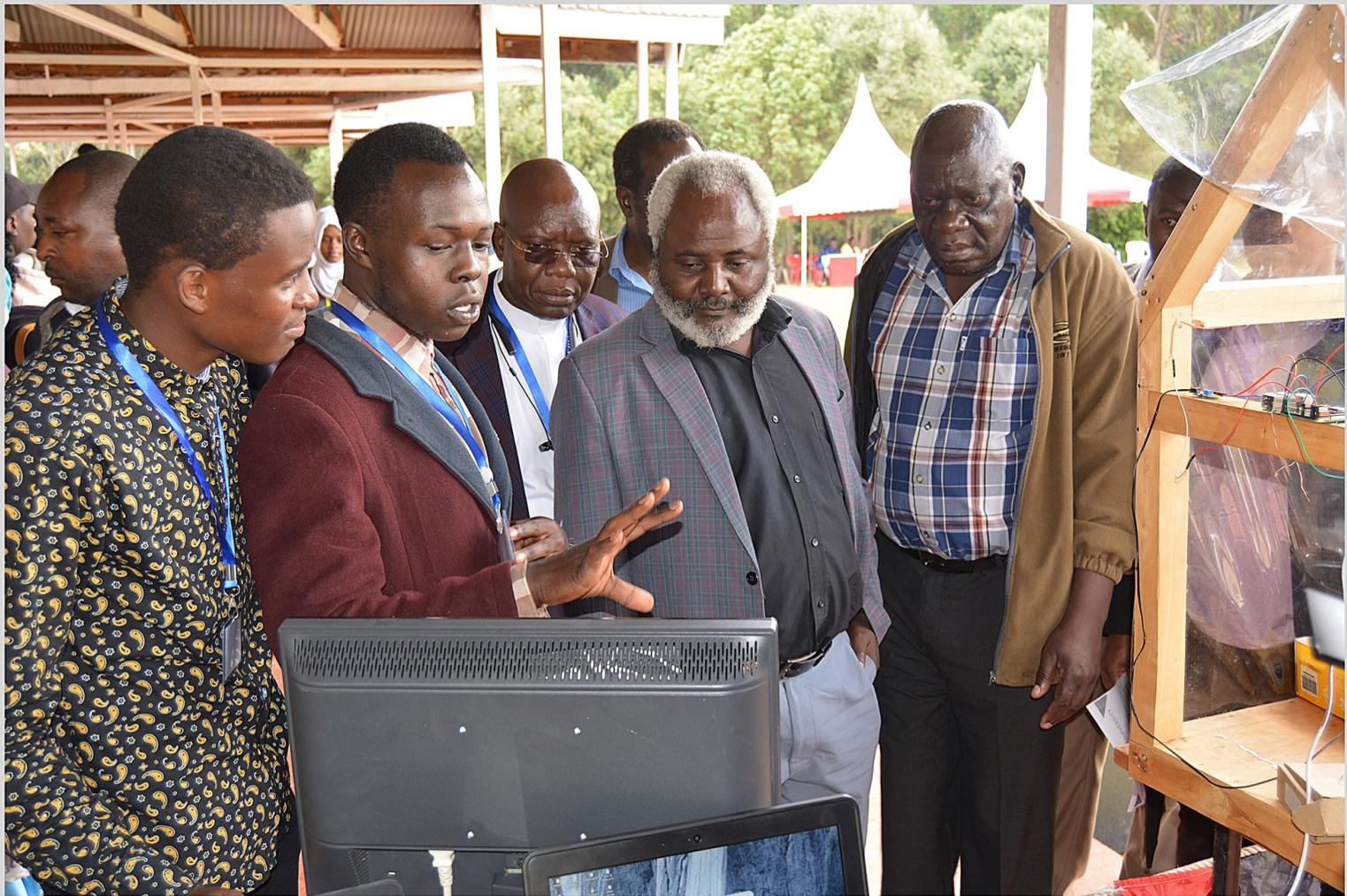

Tour to Qwetu and Qejani Hostels at CUEA

On 24th March 2023, Laikipia University was among many institutions which took part in a tour of Qwetu and Qejani Hostels at the Catholic University of East Africa (CUEA). The event was attended by Prof. Jacinta Ndambuki and Dr. Alex Kibet. They explored and learnt a lot of an example of off-campus hostels that aim to enhance the learning environment and spaces with high-speed eduroam and secure WiFi for the global academic community. KENET as the NREN of Kenya, is the National Roaming Operator of eduroam in Kenya. KENET considers student hostels to be learning spaces to support both blended and online learning. They have therefore promised to extend eduroam to off-campus hostels just like the case of Qwetu and Qejani Hostels. The student hostel eduroam initiative aims to extend eduroam WiFi to on-campus and off-campus hostels. KENET has already piloted with a few off-campus hostels at Laikipia University. The tour to Qwetu and Qejani was also an explored example of

Private Partnership in the Development of Student Hostels that was developed by ACORN. KENET considers Student Hostels as part of the learning environment, especially with increased blended learning. KENET has thus partnered with ACORN to extend high-speed eduroam WiFi to all Qwetu/Qejani Hostels. This is part of KNETs off-campus Internet initiative of KENET.
